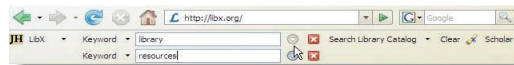

Introducing Library Plugins, Widgets & Betas

LibX Toolbar:



Search the libraries' catalog, Google Scholar, and FindIt right from this Firefox toolbar. A right-click menu sends searches where you want them and gives proxy access to the libraries' subscriptions from off-campus. Plus, embedded on-page links give you one-click access to the libraries from Amazon.

Search Plugins:



Add the libraries' catalog, WorldCat, or another database to the search box in the upper corner of Firefox or Internet Explorer.

Fulltext Referrer:



Add the FindIt button to your Google Scholar, Google News, or other web results.
