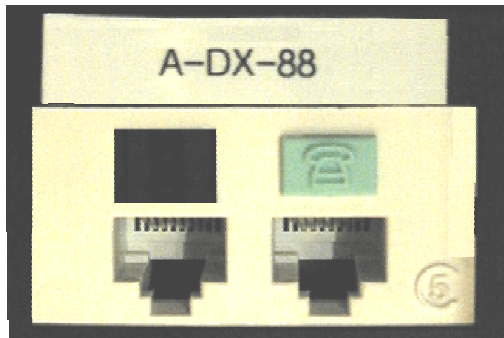

Where can I plug in my laptop in Eisenhower Library?

Active jacks in the library are marked with a black tab.



Look for active jacks on desks and the wall on the south end of levels A - D (near the windows.)

Notes:

Idle sessions are timed out for security reasons and will require re-authentication to use the JH network.

Laptop JHARS Registration

The Johns Hopkins Address Registration System (JHARS) is used to register your laptop with the network. Take the following steps:

- Open a web browser. You will be directed to JHARS to register your system.
- If the JHARS screen does not appear, type in <http://jhars.nts.jhu.edu>
- Enter your JHED LoginID (LID) and JHED password.
- Select “Register for a dynamic IP address.”
- Select your system type and operating system type from the pull down menus. Click “Next.”
- Select “MSE Library” from pull down list of buildings. Leave the space for room blank. Click “Submit Request.”
- Reboot your system.

When your registration is complete you may use the network by opening a web browser. When you do, you will be prompted to logon to the network. Enter your JHED LID as your User ID and your JHED password for the password.

Each time you restart your web browser you will be asked to login again with your JHED LoginID and password.



Please note:

To use the Johns Hopkins network you must register your laptop in the Johns Hopkins Address Registration System (JHARS).

This JHARS Registration is a one-time process and will not have to be done again for your device this semester.

An active entry in the Johns Hopkins Enterprise Directory (JHED) is required before you can register. For more information about JHED refer to “JHED Account” in the right hand column of this page.

How do I find my JHED Login information?

Step 1

You will need to work from a computer connected to the Johns Hopkins intranet. A computer accessing the network from your dorm room, the computer lab in Krieger Hall or one of the library’s public workstations will do.

Step 2

Open a web browser and go to <http://jhed.jhu.edu> or <http://jhed.jhmi.edu>.

Step 3

Click the “Login” tab.

Step 4

Follow the instructions on the login page to find out your Login ID and to set your password.
