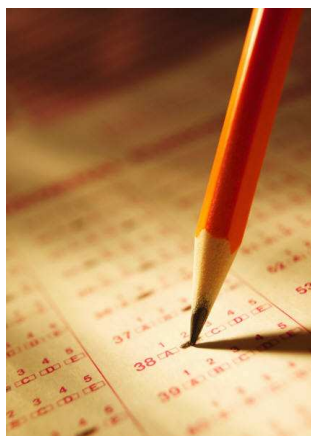

What Are the Blue Label Ps?!?

No, it's not a geeky library band. Books in the “P” call numbers (language and literature) acquired since 1996 have blue spine labels and are shelved together on D-Level. Books that were cataloged before 1996 with locally created “P” call numbers (ones that don't follow the standard Library of Congress classification system we now use) are shelved in the “white label” P section on D-Level. Be sure to note in the library catalog whether the location says “Eisenhower D-Level Blue Labels.”
