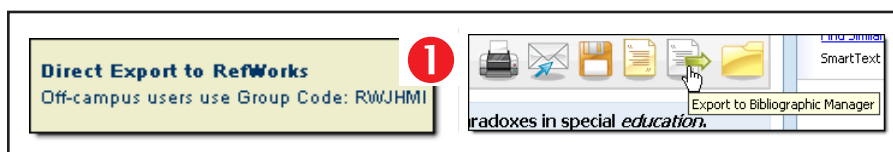


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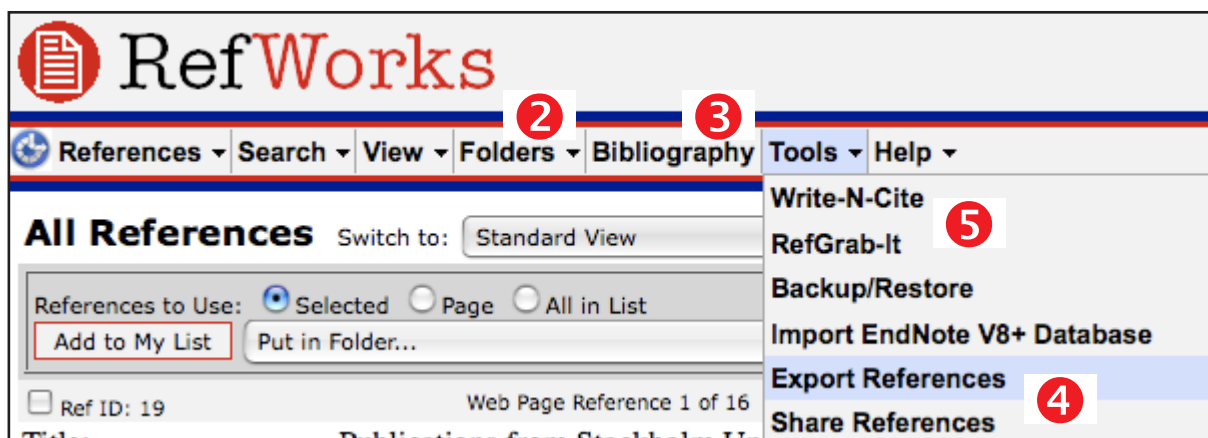


Bibliography? Easy. Basic Steps for Managing Your Citations with RefWorks



1 Export Citations to RefWorks

Export citations directly from the library catalog or research databases. Watch for "Export" or "RefWorks" options. Log in with your JHED ID and password.



2 Organize with Folders

Writing multiple papers or keeping track of many subjects? Organize by tagging citations into folders.

4 Share Lists

Share a citation list online with whomever you choose.

3 Export Bibliographies

Create bibliographies in any standard citation style with one click. Export directly to Word, HTML, and more.

5 Extend RefWorks

Write-N-Cite works with Word. Cite the web with RefGrabIt.

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
