## Using Periodicals in Research



### 1. "How do I find articles in 20<sup>th</sup> century periodicals?"

#### **MLA International Bibliography**

Consists of bibliographic records pertaining to literature, language, linguistics, and folklore, and includes coverage from 1963 to the present. Provides access to scholarly research in over 4,000 journals and series. It also covers relevant monographs, working papers, proceedings, bibliographies, and other formats.

#### **Bibliografía de la literatura española desde 1980**

1980-present) La más completa y única bibliografía sobre la Literatura Española actual. #### **Humanities Fulltext**

A database of articles that cites articles from English-language periodicals, plus the full text of selected periodicals. Subjects covered: Archaeology, Area Studies, Art, Classical Studies, Communications, Dance, Film, Folklore, Gender Studies, History, Journalism, Linguistics, Literary & Social Criticism Literature, Music, Performing Arts, Philosophy, Religion and Theology.

#### **Arts and Humanities Citation Index**

A multidisciplinary database covering the journal literature of the arts and humanities. It indexes 1,144 of the world's leading arts and humanities journals, as well as covering individually selected, relevant items from over 6,800 major science and social science journals. Provides access to current information and retrospective data from 1975 forward. Do a *Cited Reference Search* and *Find Related Records*, to expand your searching forwards and sideways.

#### **JSTOR.**

An electronic archive of journal articles that includes backfiles of nearly 50 literary journals (JSTOR adds titles every year). They are completely searchable and include the full-text of articles in several formats. JSTOR does not, however, usually include recent years of journals. But it does go back to the early 20<sup>th</sup> century in coverage, and thus acts as an index to articles that are not covered in most electronic (and print) indexes.

### **Project MUSE.**

Searches the recent years of online journals of the JHU Press. Full-text of articles now includes other presses as well; including Oxford University, Carnegie Mellon, MIT Press, Duke University.

### **Handbook of Latin American Studies**

A bibliography on Latin America consisting of works selected and annotated by scholars. Edited by the Hispanic Division of the Library of Congress, the multidisciplinary *Handbook* alternates annually between the social sciences and the humanities. Each year, more than 130 academics from around the world choose over 5,000 works for inclusion in the *Handbook*. Continuously published since 1936, the *Handbook* offers Latin Americanists an essential guide to available resources.

### **Hispanic American Periodicals Index (HAPI)**

Complete bibliographic citations to articles, book reviews, documents, original literary works, and other materials appearing in more than 500 key social science and humanities journals published throughout the world. Covers current political, economic, and social issues, and Latin American arts and letters. Many of the citations are linked to full text.

### **Traces: llengua i literatura catalanes**

A catalog of Catalan language and literature. *Servei d'Informació Bibliogràfica de Llengua i Literatura Catalanes*, from the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona. Essential for Catalan literature, very useful for Peninsular literature as well. A searchable database of articles in journals.

### **Materiales de investigacion: indice de articulos de revistas (1939-1949)**

A 2-volume set, alphabetical by subject. Indexes 10 years of Spanish periodicals, covering material not included in any database.

### **Romanische Bibliographie.**

An annual publication of work in the field of Romance languages and literature. Each year includes a large section on Spanish literature, arranged by time period, and then by author. Includes a lot of non-English sources. Includes Catalan and Galician literature. A resource not to be overlooked.

### **The year's work in modern language studies.**

Critically assess major articles, books and new editions. Better coverage of English language than Spanish language publications. Very useful introduction to recent secondary literature.

**Internationale Bibliographie der Zeitschriftenliteratur (IBZ)**

An international and interdisciplinary bibliography of academic periodical literature mainly from the Humanities, Social Sciences and Arts. Contains over 2,553,260 journal articles from about 10,785 journals covering the years 1983 -.

**Bibliografía de la literatura hispánica.** J. Simón Díaz

The indispensable bibliography for Spanish literature. Still a work in progress (it has reached *Francisco Pacheco* in the alphabet), but at 16 volumes to date it is an essential resource for general literature, the Middle Ages, and Golden Age. Includes Castilian, Catalan, Galician, Basque, and Spanish American (up to independence) literatures. Volume 1 covers literary history, Volume 2 bibliographies and catalogs, Volume 3 the Middle Ages, and Volumes 4-16 Golden Age.

**Manual de bibliografía de la literatura española.** J. Simon Diaz.

Treats *Fuentes generales, Edad media, Siglos de Oro, Siglo XVIII, Siglo XIX, and Siglo XX.* Alphabetical by author; lists works written and then works about. Includes subject index.

### **Periodicals Contents Index (PCI)**

Periodicals Contents Index is an electronic index to millions of articles published in thousands of periodicals in the arts, humanities and social sciences since 1770. Includes Spanish titles.

**Literature Criticism from 1400 to 1800:** Excerpts From Criticism of the Works of Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Seventeenth, and Eighteenth-Century Novelists, Poets, Playwrights, Philosophers, and Other Creative Writers, From the First Published Critical Appraisals to Current Evaluations.

Detroit: Gale Research, 1984-

Compilation, primarily of critical writings, concerning writers active between 1400-1800 and important topics for the period. Follows other, similar Gale products and provides bio-bibliographical information. Contains author, topics, nationalities, and titles indexes that cumulate in the latest issue. Lists **critical writings** in chronological order, **many of which are in periodicals**. The organization of each volume by writer provides index to periodical literature before 1900. Allows readers to trace the reception of writers and their critical reputation over time. (Balay)

4. ***"How do I find information about Spanish periodicals, including publication history, major writers, ties to literary movements and lists of journals published in a particular time period?"***

**Literatura y periodismo en las revistas del Fin de Siglo : estudio e indices (1888-1907).**

A study of 20 fin-de-siglo periodicals, with complete listing of contents. An index in the back makes it a very useful tool for material that is not otherwise indexed.
